We are giving flu vaccines to patients who are 6 months and older and parents.

We are offering injectable preservative free quadrivalent vaccine to our patients and parents. We are not offering flu mist to our patients this year. The CDC released an advisory that the flu mist has proven to be minimally effective against protection from the flu.

If you have been to our office for an appointment since April of this year, you are aware that we are now using Phreesia, an electronic check-in system, for your child. You will receive an appointment reminder via e-mail for your child's flu vaccine as well as a flu questionnaire. You will only need to verify your insurance and complete the flu questionnaire prior to your visit.

In order to expedite your visit, *we urge you to complete the pre-check and flu questionnaire PRIOR to your visit.*
